Appositives are used to reduce wordiness, add detail, and add syntactic variety to a sentence. For example, you can combine two simple sentences to create one sentence that contains an appositive.

The Appositive. 1. THE APPOSITIVE. Recognize an appositive when you find one. An appositive is a nounor noun phrasethat renames another noun right beside it. The appositive can be a short or long combination of words. Read these appositive examples, all of which rename intruder: The intruder, a cockroach, is crawling across the kitchen table. The intruder, a large, inquisitive cockroach, is crawling across the kitchen table.

The Appositive

An appositive is a noun or noun phrase that renames another noun that comes right before it. When the appositive is nonessential, you set it off with commas. Nonessential means that you don't need the appositive to completely understand the sentence. When the appositive is essential, you do not use commas.
