Emergency procedures for the full range of possible incidents should be made known to new and temporary members of staff as soon as possible after their appointment. All occupants of a school, with the possible exception of very young children, must be able to recognise alarm signals within their school and should be familiar with the available escape routes and assembly points after evacuation.

See the evacuation plaques posted in hallways. If you are teaching in areas with no windows, or at night, be prepared to evacuate in darkness if any of the emergency exit lighting has failed. Discuss this with your students.

Classroom Emergency Preparedness and Response

There are three broad areas of safety and emergency response instruction that apply to classrooms. a. Classroom safety procedures (use of chemicals, lab equipment, in class injuries or medical emergencies, etc.) b. Building evacuation reasons and procedures (in case of fire, e.g.)

CHECKLIST FOR CLASSROOM SAFETY & EMERGENCY INFORMATION

Make sure that areas of the classroom with unavoidable tripping hazards (such as reading corners with floor cushions) are designated \u2014no-running\u2014 zones. Encourage Proper Hygiene. Instruct kids to wash their hands frequently throughout the day, especially after using the bathroom and before eating.
