Clausewitz defines the "single elements" of his subject and thus to advance from the simple to the complex while outlining the shape of the whole (that is, war). War is defined as "an act of violence to compel our opponent to fulfill our will." Violence is the means, the imposition of will is the end.

Clausewitz argues that the purpose of war is to disarm your opponent and thereby force him to give you what you want. Based on this premise, he concludes that wars are essentially unwinnable on the battlefield: it is virtually impossible to completely disarm your opponent through might alone.
