Research Question: To what extent will my use of historical empathy and modeling to teach about an historical event impact my students' essay writing and fact retention and historical analysis during an in-class essay? Research Activities: Context: This intervention took place in my 11th grade, 4th period, U.S. History class at C.K. McClatchy High School in Sacramento, California. There were 31 students in this class, which consisted of 9 girls and 22 boys. Fifty-five percent of my 4th period students were re-designated English-language learners. Furthermore, half of the 4th period students tested at basic and below in English language arts.

The intervention took place over a period of 4 weeks, which included a break of one week for fall semester final exams. Methods and Data: The purpose of this intervention was to explore whether or not my use of historical empathy as an instructional strategy would deepen student connection to and understanding of history. The intervention was organized around the 1920's unit of study. The primary focus of the unit was the idea of "culture clash." A variety of activities were introduced, including context building through the use of primary source documents, group analysis of documents, music, films, teacher-guided discussions, and role-playing. At all points, my students were asked to make personal connections to the material by either assuming the role of a person from the era, or by responding to prompts on graphic organizers. Two writing assignments were given to help prepare students for the final exam.

These assignments were collected as homework. Furthermore, the students turned in a unit portfolio, which was a collection of all classwork and homework. The final assessment was an in-class exam given on February 6th, 2009. The exam was scored according to a teacher-created rubric. Additionally, pre-and-post intervention attitudinal data were collected through student surveys. Results: Individual student performance was tracked through the collection of writing assignments. The results were inconclusive. While the overall average of the class test score rose 9 points to 84%, that success was not replicated in other collected writing assignments. However, the post attitudinal data demonstrated that when historical empathy is used as an instructional strategy, students are more likely to feel engaged with history and sympathize with people from the past. incorporating computerized instruction into developmental mathematics courses. The study examined achievement, retention, persistence, and success of students who began in Elementary Algebra, progressed into Intermediate Algebra and subsequently obtained their goal of completing an initial college-level mathematics course. The college-level courses consist of College Algebra, Introductory Statistics, or Contemporary Mathematics. Two groups of elementary algebra students from Chattanooga State Technical Community College were used in this study. One group was taught using a lecture based approach and one group was taught using a computerized instructional approach. The lecture group consisted of 175 students where the computer group consisted of 208 students. Achievement was studied using elementary algebra final exam grades and overall course grades from students who

were enrolled in elementary algebra during the fall 2002 semester. Retention was studied using students who began in the fall 2002 semester in elementary algebra, tracking them, to see if they enrolled in a mathematics course during the spring 2003 semester. Persistence was studied using students who began elementary algebra in the fall 2002 semester, enrolled in a mathematics course during the spring 2003 semester and persisted with their mathematics by registering for a mathematics course in the summer 2003 semester or the fall 2003 semester. Student success was studied using students who began in the elementary algebra course in the fall 2002 semester and successfully completed a college mathematics course by the fall 2003 semester. Success was determined by the number of students who made a letter grade of an A, B or C in any college level mathematics course. When

examining achievement, retention, persistence and success, the only area in this study that showed a significant difference was among the achievement rates. The lecture students' achievement rates were significantly higher than the students who received computerized instruction. Retention, persistence and success did not show any significant difference between the two groups.
