For the bronze medal, NOCs carefully makes an alloy of copper and other elements, usually tin and zinc, to form a strong bronze medal that is resistant to erosion. The three metal compositions are 97% copper, 2.5% zinc, and 0.5% tin. The size and dimensions remain similar to that of gold and silver medals.
