It was the second of Sophocles' three Theban plays to be produced, but it comes first in the internal chronology (followed by "Oedipus at Colonus" and then "Antigone").

When Creon retells the story of Laius's murder, Oedipus is shocked and dismayed that the investigation of the murder of a king was so swiftly dropped (145–147). Oedipus quickly hatches plans to deal with both his people's suffering and Laius's unsolved murder, and he has even anticipated the Chorus's suggestions that he send someone to the oracle and call forth Tiresias.
