DOGMATIC CONSTITUTION ON THE CHURCH

Lumen Gentium represents an important synthesis of Biblical, Patristic, medieval and Tridentine ecclesiology, combined with orthodox elements of the new theological movement. Understanding Lumen Gentium is essential to the interpretation of the Council's subsequent documents, especially Unitatis Redintegratio. It is critical to take the document in its entirety, rather than to select some sections over others.

Commentary on Lumen Gentium - Arcane Knowledge

The Dogmatic Constitution on the Church is a central document that increased the authority, identity, and the mission of the church. In line with all significant Roman Catholic Church documents, it is colloquially known ad Lumen Gentium (Light of the Nations), the first words in the document. It was passed by 2,151 votes to 5 of present bishops.
